
Project Goals:

To work for an annual improvement in the quality of GME provision in Edinburgh from 0-18, using as a best practice guide the Foghlam Alba document: *Advice on Gaelic Education (February 2015)*.

To work towards the establishment of new accommodation for nursery, primary and secondary GME pupils to ensure GME remains open to all who wish it for their family.

Steps to achieve the above:

- 1. Work with Councillors and Council officers to implement goals of the Edinburgh Council GLP (2018-22) and the Council's Gaelic Medium Education Improvement Plan and Growth Strategy (December 2018).
- 2. Communicate regularly with parents to provide information and ask for feedback.
- 3. Hold regular open meetings with parents to gain consensus on potential accommodation options, and new GME subjects to be delivered at secondary.
- 4. Ensure positive outcome for public consultation on primary and secondary options.
- 5. Work with Scottish Government and other national organisations to source additional funding and support.
